"The Samuel E. Paley Pavilion at the Rehabilitation Center for Children and Adults at 300 Royal Palm Way was built between 1965 and 1966. It was designed by John L. Volk. It was funded by Mrs. Goldie Paley in honor of her husband Samuel and with matching grants from the federal government. The coquina background forms a contrast with the metal screen that covers the large windows of the interior room. The interior space houses the therapeutic pool. The screen allows for natural light and sun to penetrate the interior while providing privacy. Though made from a rigid metal material, the screen mimics the Royal Palm trees that flank the structure today just as they appear on John Volk's original rendering. The Samuel E. Paley Pavilion is

important to the Town of Palm Beach for both its history and its architecture. The Rehabilitation Center for Children and Adults has been in existence since 1940, serving the needs of the citizens with outstanding therapy, care and kindness. John Volk's design for the Paley Pavilion contributes to the importance of this gateway to the island."
